



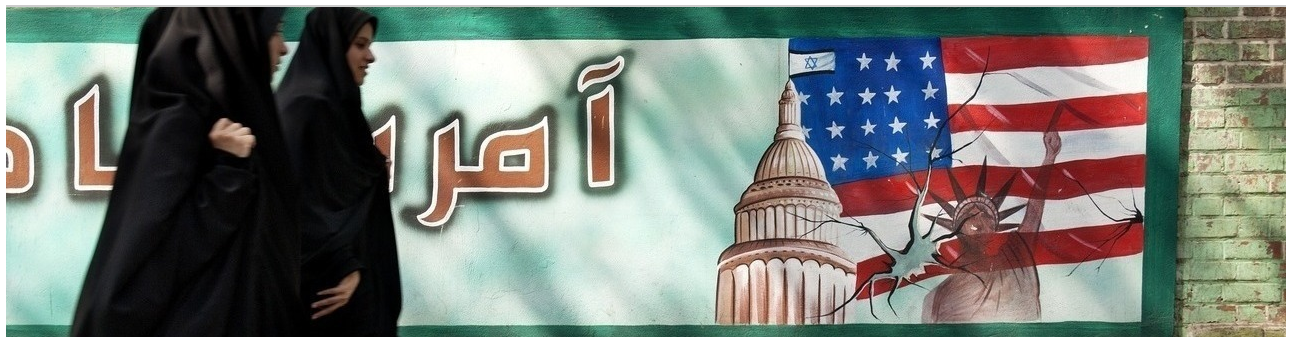

The Atlantic Council and the Friedrich Ebert Foundation (FES) are pleased to invite you to a public panel discussion to assess the strategic implications and consequences of the United States' "maximum pressure" campaign against Tehran.

In a paper published by the Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung this month, five distinguished experts discuss the longerterm ramifications of the U.S. withdrawal from the nuclear deal with regard to Iran's domestic situation, economy, and Middle East policy, as well as US policy towards Iran and European-Iranian relations. **We have invited some of these authors to the Atlantic Council to present their findings.**

U.S. sanctions are taking a huge toll on Iran, especially on the general public. Nevertheless, they have failed to deprive Tehran of the capability to develop a nuclear weapon or change its regional posture and Washington's strategic endgame remains unclear. If anything, a year after the re-imposition of sanctions, the Middle East is experiencing three interlinked crises: an economic crisis (most profoundly in Iran, but with geopolitical spillovers to other countries), a non-proliferation crisis, and a deepening of the region's geopolitical crisis.
